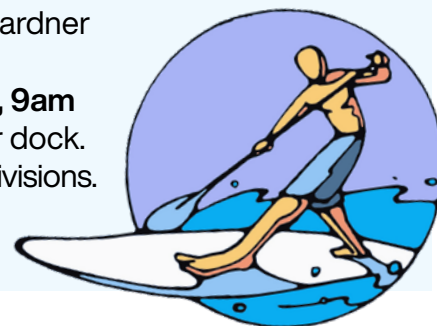

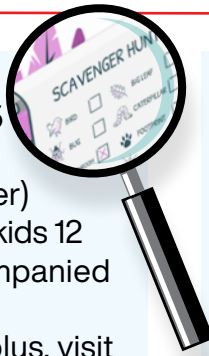

SIMPLE SAILBOAT RACING RULES

DUTY OF SKIPPER TO REVIEW RACE COURSE-NOTICE OF RACE INSTRUCTIONS

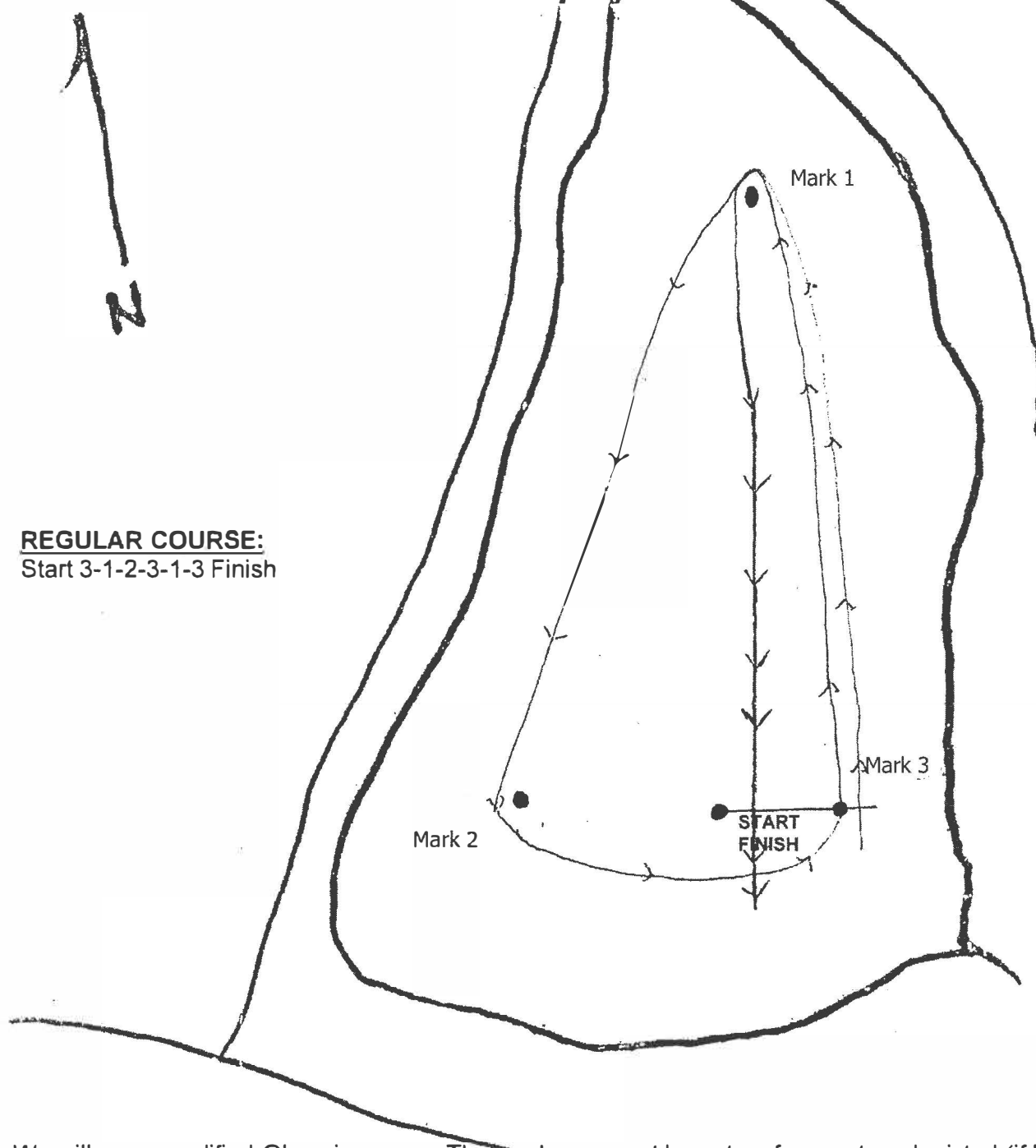
1. **START**: No one is to be forward of the line (in the direction of the first mark buoy) prior to the gun, horn or siren signaling start. If you go over early, you must go back again and restart. Boats that started correctly on time proceed to marks. The Race Committee will handicap boats and skippers for timing sequence for each boat's start.
2. **MARKS**: Or buoy course indicator must all be rounded counterclockwise on port side of boat (left) *. If you hit mark, you must make a one turn penalty. That turn includes one tack, one gybe (no longer a 360° turn). Failure to do so is **DSQ**. *reverse course – clockwise right
3. **RIGHT OF WAY**: A starboard tack boat has right of way over a port tack boat. Starboard tack is the wind coming over the starboard side (right side) of boat. When the boom is on the port side of the boat-you are on a starboard tack.
4. **LEEWARD BOAT**: Has right of way over windward boat. This applies when both boats are on the same tack. The leeward side is where the boom is.
5. **OVERTAKING**: Overtaking boat has no rights. If you are coming up fast behind another boat, you must avoid them, even if the slower boat moves to block you.
6. **COLLISIONS**: Generally both boats disqualified. An avoidable collision will get the boat that did not have right-of-way disqualified. If you had to avoid a collision and were in the right say Protest and tell race committee at end of race. If you damage another's boat, you are responsible as collision should be avoided at all costs to avoid injury to all.
7. **ROUNDING A MARK**: If you are approaching a mark with another boat, the boat on course closer to the mark has the right-of-way to round the mark and the outside boat or inside boat must stay clear and give the other boat room to round the mark and can't squeeze a closer boat to make it avoid collision or give you room. Failure to do this may result in disqualification as hitting a mark and not making a penalty turn. **(DSQ)**
8. **DID NOT FINISH**: If you fail to finish the course, you are given a **DNF** (did not finish), if you have a collision or fail to give another boat the right of way you are given a **DSQ** (disqualification); if you do not start but were on course near start line you are given a **DNS** (did not start).
9. **NO IMPORTED BOATS OR SKIPPERS**: Must be boats customarily used on lake by owner or family.

REGULAR COURSE:

Start 3-1-2-3-1-3 Finish

We will run a modified Olympic course. The marks may not be set as far apart as depicted (if less wind) but will require sailing counter clockwise around Marks 1, 2, 3 and then sailing around Mark 1 to the finish. All Marks to be rounded port side. The finish line will be between a set buoy and the committee boat at Mark 3. In case of thunder and/or lightning, the race will be postponed due to possible danger - leave the course immediately and seek shelter.

NOTICE: No flying of spinnakers permitted in order to level the playing field.
